New Art Students,

It's time to get ready for a new and exciting year of art!

I am excited about introducing your artist to the world of oil painting!

I will only take a limited number of students in each class. I will work with each student at their own pace and each student will be painting something different. I will be instructing you on sketching, color mixtures, brush strokes, shading, highlighting, perspective, blending, and many other oil painting methods.

The initial fee will include the monthly fee, a \$25 registration fee, and the cost of the new art caddy.

The instruction fee is **\$90.00** per month for one lesson each week and the fee is due on the first lesson of each month. Some months you will get 3 lessons, some 4, and some 5. I accept Venmo, cash, and checks. My Venmo is @rhondadixonart. There is a payment basket located on the art supply shelves. Checks can be made out to Rhonda Dixon. If you are paying cash, please put the cash in an envelope with the student's name on it. Envelopes are provided on the shelf behind the payment basket if you need one.

Classes will be held at my studio in my home at 507 Holly Drive. Please enter through the carport. Please do not drop your child off before 3:30 and promptly pick up them up at 5:45.

An art class calendar will be sent by email and/or Remind. There will be some months that I will only have class for half of the month and your fee will be half.

I **DO NOT** do make-up classes. If a student is absent, the lesson will NOT be able to be made up. I will make up the class if I have to cancel. Most months there will be 4 lessons per month, but some will have 3 and some 5. If you are out for a sports season or an extended time, you will have to pay for your spot to keep it.

I will have an **ART CADDY** with all your supplies ready for you on the first day. The cost will be \$150 for the art caddy, 9 oil paints, brushes, palette knife, canvas, the first jar of mineral spirits and all other supplies you will need to start off the new year. You will need some supplies each month for the rest of the year such as a new canvas each time you start a new painting and clean mineral spirits (to wash brushes); also, if you run out of a tube of paint (we use a good deal of white) and new brushes if you do not take care of them. Also, you will need a clean jar of mineral spirits when the one you have gets dirty. I have more paint colors and extra supplies for purchase when your student wants to add new supplies as they progress.

By requests of parents, I carry art supplies in the studio. A price list is available in the studio. Snacks are available to purchase, also. I will have a book with a page for each student to have an account. You may charge supplies and snacks or have a running credit if you wish to put money on your account. Please check your student's page regularly. Some parents choose to add \$10-\$20 per month and I apply it to their charge page. Some parents choose to only pay their balance each month. I am flexible and will do whatever works for each student.

It is very important to keep your brushes clean! I will give your student instructions in class on how to wash their brushes. Also, please keep your supplies up to date. In order to learn to paint, an artist needs clean brushes and the correct materials to work with.

I will be communicating through the **REMIND 101** app. Please be sure that I have added you to the correct Remind class and that you are receiving my messages.
